








This outstanding masterpiece in Wrought-Rite ornamental iron by Kupferer Bros. is one of the most impressive installations in the United States in recent years.

The original fence was completed in 1862 as the finishing touch to what at that time was the most outstanding courthouse in the nation. However, the sandstone base into which the fence was set deteriorated, and the fence itself was removed late in the last century.

The restoration of the Old Courthouse was made a part of the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial project. To Kupferer Bros. was assigned the work of restoring the historic old fence.

Kupferer Bros. did considerable research before beginning the restoration. Particularly noteworthy is the "turtle design" in the lower panel of the gate. It is absolutely unique among wrought iron motifs, and is said to have been inspired by "Quigley's turtle," a pet which lived in the garden fountain.



ROM early Colonial times, ornamental iron has been an important means of adding beauty as well as strength to buildings and other structures. Many examples of lovely ornamental iron dating back hundreds of years are still in existence, monuments to the skill of the early craftsmen who created the designs.

In recent years, ornamental iron has become increasingly popular, and many new applications in contemporary architecture are being continually developed. New patterns are also being designed and older ones improved, and the resultant versatility is an important reason why ornamental iron today enjoys greater acceptance than ever.

A contributing factor in the new-found popularity of ornamental iron is the discovery of new and faster methods of production, bringing its cost within reach of the average homeowner. Durability, too, is improved because of the use of new metal alloys. Finishing by sand blasting produces smoother surfaces. Patterns are adapted for easier installation. Also facilitating installation is the fact that dimensions and weights of Wrought-Rite products are uniformly accurate.


All posts to be either 11/4" or 2" square tubing as required; 1/2" solid steel pickets (pointed or otherwise) on 5" centers; individual horizontal channels  $1\frac{1}{4}''x^{1}/2''x^{1}/8''$ ; except for Top channels covered and re-inforced by molded steel caprail, then they will be of 1"x1/2"x1/8". Scrolls when used, to be of  $\frac{3}{16}$ " x  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip steel. Note: (On the #900 & #901 fence when made over 42" finished height, an extra center horizontal channel is used.

# DO-IT-YOURSELF ADJUSTABLE RAILING

Shown here are the parts and parts numbers used to make the Wrought-Rite adjustable railing.


PART No. 704 — Completely adjustable 4'-0" section of railing.

PART No. 706 — Completely adjustable 6'-0" section of railing, suitable for step or platform railing. The materials used in fabrication are: ½" x 1" x ½" channels for top and bottom rails, and twisted pickets made of 3/16" x ½" band iron set 6" center to center.

PART No. 708 — Newel Post. 1" square tubing 36" long and pre-drilled for attaching to railings. Cap is a cast aluminum fitting factory-pressed into post. Newel posts may be used as corner, intermediate or end posts.

PART No. 701—Lamb's Tongue. Material consists of ½" x 1" x ½" channels. This is an "extra" to enhance the appearance of the finished railing.

PART No. 705—Center Support, 1" square and 6" long. Should be used when railing section is over 4'-0" long but under 6'-0" long.



PART No. 700 — Base Flange for Newel Post, used to attach newel post to surface of masonry floor or where railings are installed on a wood deck.

PART No. 707—Adjustable Fittings. Packaged in one set of 4 each. Set is required with each section of railing. Furnished with 1/4" x 13/4" round head bolts and nuts and 1/4" x 1/2" oval head bolts.

PART No. 709—Single Column. Material is 1" square structural tubing with ½" x 1" x ½" channel dividers. The picket is ½" x 3/16" band iron. The top plate is pre-drilled for ease of erection. These columns are adjustable from 6'10" to 8'0". They are 9½" wide.

PART No. 710 — Angle Column. This is built with the same specification as Part No. 709, the single column.

PART No. 702— Small Scroll. Material is 3/8" x 3/16" band iron. Scrolls are 7½" wide and 12" long.


PART No. 703—Large Scroll. Material is same as small scroll. These larger scrolls are 7½" wide and 21" long. Large and small scrolls may also be added to columns.



All channels are punched to receive the round bars. Where each bar passes through the channel, it is arc welded. The clips are welded in the end of channel inset approximately 1/16" for better erection. A center cross bar is used on any window guard over 42" high.



These rugged Wrought-Rite window guards are built for maximum protection . . . maximum light and ventilation. A one-inch space is left at top and bottom of frame for ease of painting and cleaning.




Wrought-Rite window well grates are made of expanded metal which combines light weight with unusual strength because each diamond is designed like a truss; every strand works to distribute the load in many directions to the supporting structure. (Note truss-like construction of expanded metal in illustration at right.)

This expanded metal is framed with 1½" x 1½" x 3/16" angle iron on all guards. The only guards not fabricated in this manner are the half-circle and irregular shaped covers. On these guards a ½" x 1½" flat bar forms the edge.











